Who attends the Gathering?

The Gathering has been running for over 18 years. You can see pictures from our last event in June 2022 here.

The Gathering is attended by over 2,000 people across the two day event. The majority of the audience are from the voluntary sector in Scotland. Each session attracts different audiences, from chief executives to managers to trustees and volunteers. Public sector staff working with the voluntary sector also attend.

We have high profile guests and speakers each year. In 2022, this included:

- Nicola Sturgeon MSP, Scotland's First Minister (2014-2023)
- Jack Monroe, Food writer and poverty campaigner
- Iain Stewart MP, Parliamentary Under Secretary of State for Scotland
- Dolly Parton, Musician (via video)







What's on the programme?

Over 70 workshops, seminars and training sessions take place across the two days, with up to eight events running concurrently. Most events last for one hour.

People can choose to attend just one event or create their own full programme across the two days.

Showcasing work of organisations on topics ranging from children's literacy to the environment

As well as the programmed events, there is an exhibition space where organisations can showcase their work while people meet with like-minded friends and collegues, old and new.

Workshops and seminars vary widely, including:

Learning events on topics such as communications or cyber security

Inspirational, thinking and policy events

The focus of the event will be in-person activities, but we will also have hybrid and digital experiences to extend the reach of the event to those who cannot make it in person.



Where and when will it take place?

This year, we're bringing the Gathering to the EICC, Edinburgh on 7 and 8 November 2023.

Who runs the Gathering?

The Gathering is run by the Scottish Council for Voluntary Organisations (SCVO). SCVO is the national membership body for Scotland's vibrant voluntary sector.

We champion the sector, provide services and debate big issues.

We're passionate about what the voluntary sector can achieve. Along with our community of 3,000+ members, we believe that charities, social enterprises and voluntary groups make Scotland a better place.

We lobby government on policy issues, create jobs for young people and support organisations to embrace and promote digital skills. We also help with day-to-day stuff, like affordable office space, training courses, funding opportunities and information and support to help people set up and run their organisations.




