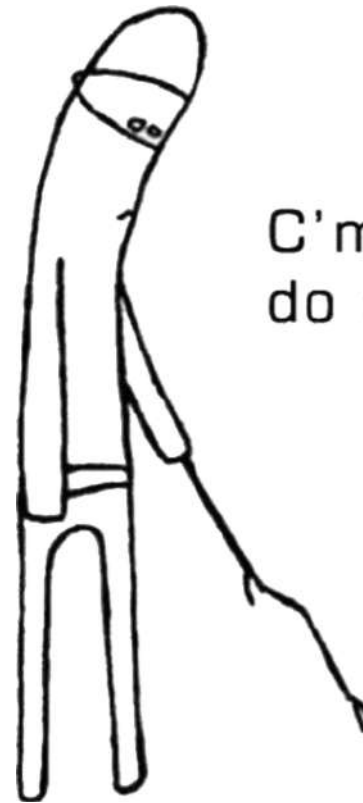
Frequency at which searches result in zero clicks

Reasons for Cycling

The sources provide several motives for people to cycle, with a particular emphasis on the societal and personal benefits:

- **Environmental benefits:** Cycling reduces greenhouse gas emissions and vehicle miles traveled ^{1 2}. For example, shifting short car trips to cycling can save 13 million tons of CO2 emissions annually ³. In the UK, swapping a car for a bike for just one day a week can reduce an individual's carbon footprint by about 0.5 tonnes over a year ⁴.
- **Health and well-being:** Cycling offers **incidental exercise** and promotes physical and mental well-being ^{2 5 6 7 8}. It can help prevent chronic conditions like heart disease, type 2 diabetes, and depression ⁹. Studies show that cycling to work is associated with a lower risk of developing cancer, heart disease, and premature death ¹⁰.
- **Cost savings:** Cycling is a more **affordable** mode of transportation than owning and maintaining a car ^{3 11 12}. The annual average cost of running a car can exceed \$15,000 ¹¹, while a bicycle is significantly cheaper ³. In Greater Manchester, a program provided free refurbished bikes to jobseekers, helping them overcome transportation barriers to employment ^{12 13}.
- **Safety:** While safety concerns can be a barrier to cycling ^{6 14}, government initiatives are addressing this issue by investing in **safe and connected bike networks**, including segregated cycle lanes and low-traffic neighborhoods ¹ ^{2 15 16 ...}. This infrastructure aims to create a more pleasant and **convenient** cycling experience ^{5 19}.
